REFLECTING THE HEART OF CHRIST - TRUTH

Key Objectives

The purpose of this lesson is to bring attention to and apply the concepts listed below and then encourage a call-to-action. The concepts are:

- God's desire to mold us into the image of Christ
- Truth is foundational to Christianity and an aspect of the character of Christ.

Discussion

Watch segment 1 of the study video before the discussion. The discussion objective is for participants to resonate with God's call to reject lies they have believed that cause them suffering and replace those lies with God's truth. Conclude the discussion in time to allow 5 minutes for the group to watch segment 2 of the video. As a facilitator, your role is to foster discussion that God can use to bring conviction to forgive. Use the questions below to stimulate the group discussion. Do not attempt to answer the question, bias the discussion or resolve disagreements.

Read John 14:30 to the group.

1. Is it possible that you believe something as true that is actually a lie? How would you know?
2. If Satan is the father of everything that is false, is it possible to believe a lie without negatively impacting your life? Explain your answer.
3. If your father tells you that you are precious and highly valued, is it true because he said it, or is it true because that statement agrees with what God says?
4. How do you feel about the concept that if you believe a lie, Satan has a better chance of tempting you?
5. How important is it that our foundational sense of self-worth is established on the truth of God rather than the lies of Satan?
6. What does the world want us to believe about how to feel valuable that opposes the truth of God?
7. How would it feel and impact your life to wholeheartedly believe you

8. If someone loved you unconditionally, would that increase your sense of value?
9. How does it impact your sense of self-worth to know that God loves you unconditionally and for eternity?
10. What lies do people believe that rob them of their confidence and self-worth?
